

Radical Innovation

Paper based

Assessments tend to be traditional, mostly focussed on examinations and institutional accountability. Most remain paper-based.

There is little investment in the development of assessment systems to support personalised learning.

Technology based

Assessment is increasingly focussed on learning and personalisation; which has resolved key issues such as e-portfolios and cross institutional transfer; and which has transformed content to assess 21st Century learning skills.

Technology is used to migrate traditional assessments from paper to computer. This replicates the traditional assessment processes.





For presenting information to learners, other stakeholders and potential employers according to their needs	For personal and group learning and development to support learners to learn new skills and knowledge and transfer them
